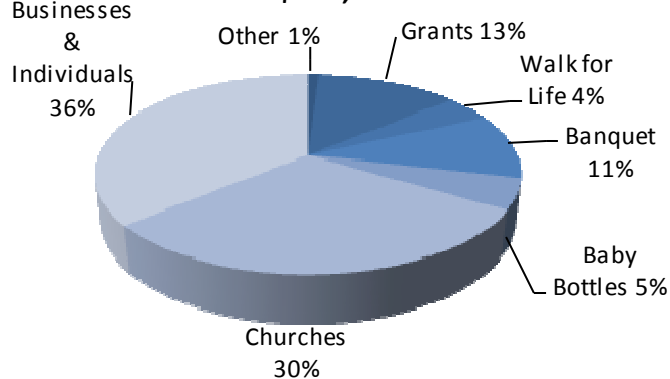

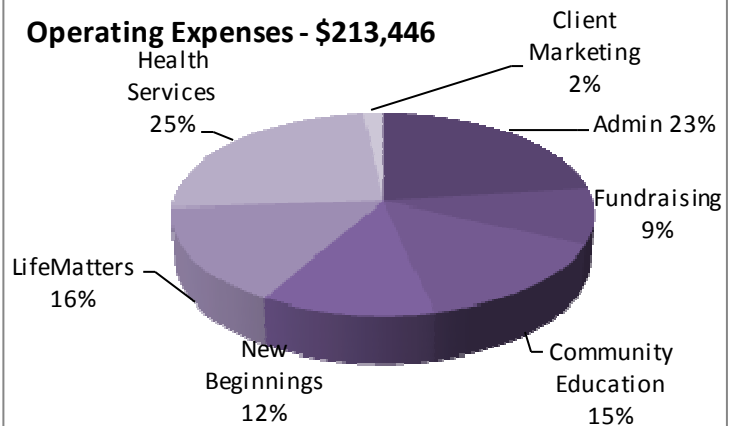
## 24 LIVES SAVED IN 2015

### HEALTH SERVICES

We believe that every mother has the right to love and support during an unexpected pregnancy. In our health services we offer free pregnancy testing, ultrasound scan, and information about their options. We are a life affirming organization and do not believe abortion is a healthy choice. Our goal is to educate the mothers we serve and empower them to choose life.

Hannah\* is one such young woman. She came to us knowing she was pregnant and planning to have an abortion the following day. She said she thought she should abort her baby, but wanted to talk to us first. After her appointment that day she left our office with an appointment for prenatal care, not an abortion. She came to us afraid abortion was her only choice, and left excited to be a mother.

### LIFEMATTERS

In the state of Pennsylvania over 88% of abortions are performed on unmarried women. We know that in order to decrease the abortion numbers we must reach young people before they become pregnant. We do this by taking our Real Essentials information into our local public schools and sharing in a fun and interactive way about healthy relationships and saving sex for marriage. Ella\* came up to us after hearing our presentation and said she spoke to her boyfriend and they decided to wait for marriage to have sex. They had never heard this message before and determined they were worth waiting for!

We believe that as Christians we must stand with families after they choose life, to encourage them and assist them in providing for their growing families.

In our New Beginnings program families attend weekly one-on-one parenting classes and in exchange earn items for their children such as diapers, wipes, baby clothes, and baby furniture. Every item in our Mom's Shop is donated and families often express gratefulness for the generous hearts of our donors.

Kayla\* came to our New Beginnings program and during her intake appointment began to weep. She was being pressured by a family member to choose abortion and knew she wanted to parent her baby but did not know how she would manage. Our staff in New Beginnings have been encouraging her for over a year now and she has been able to earn everything she needs for her beautiful child.
